Collecting pledges helps us raise even more money

LCC needs your help to raise funds for this year's scholarship drive. We're asking each bowler to reach out to family, friends, co-workers, and other loved ones to ask for pledges. We encourage each bowler to raise at least **\$25** in pledges.

How can others make pledges to you

People can make pledges based on **\$\$\$** per pin, **\$\$\$** per strikes or spares, **\$\$\$** per total score, straight donations, or any other way they choose to give.

Pledges = do-overs mark ups!

And the more **\$\$\$** you make through your pledges, the better your final score and team score will be. Here's how it works:

- Raise \$25 and pick any 1 frame to call a **do-over** and mark up to a strike X
- Raise \$50 and pick any 2 frames to call **do-overs** and mark up to strikes XX
- Raise \$100 and pick any 3 frames to call **do-overs** and mark up to strikes XXX

Did we mention the team raising the most pledges also wins a special team prize?!?!

Bowlers are responsible for collecting and remitting all pledges

Each bowler is responsible for collecting the pledges they raise and remitting them to Leadership Clark County. We plan to have remittance information established on the LCC website so you can pay up online.
